Sports Friends

Sports Friends, a program of SIM International, is empowering churches and church planters to use the universal language of sport. It partners with the local church in reaching out to youth through sport. It is proving a relevant and effective tool for evangelism and discipleship.

The program began in Ethiopia in 2001 and in February 2007, Sports Friends Africa officially opened its Nigerian office. Recently, the leaders of Sports Friends met with church and mission leaders in Asia to see if God might be calling them to work there. God gave them good meetings and potential partners in many locations. The door to Asia is wide open!

Nobody could have predicted just how effective church-centred sports ministry would be! Today, more than 1,000 trained Ethiopian evangelists are using sports to build

relationships with youth and their families. More than 500 churches have initiated sports ministry programs, both in the cities and in rural areas. New churches have been planted, and thousands of people, including many from hostile religious groups, have placed their trust in Christ. And the sports ministry movement in Ethiopia is still in its first lap!

Who would have thought that something as simple as a soccer ball could open so many doors for the gospel? If you are interested in sport and have specific skills which can be used in sports ministry, there are numerous opportunities to use these talents to build relationships with young people and share your faith in Jesus.



Current opportunities

If you have a call and a vision for reaching young people for Christ and helping them to grow in Him, in the context of a culturally sensitive area, this opportunity could be for you.
