

Prayer for the Islamic World during Ramadan



During the festival of Ramadan, many Muslims are earnestly seeking God. Would you commit to praying for the Islamic world during this period? Below are some prayer points to help inform your prayers. Since there are seven prayer points, you could commit to praying one each day of the week during Ramadan.

Monday:

"And afterward, I will pour out my Spirit on all people. Your sons and daughters will prophesy, your old men will dream dreams, your young men will see visions."

Joel 2:28

Intercede for Muslims all over the world; that they would see and accept the one true God, Jehovah. Pray that God might reveal himself through dreams and visions or however the Lord decides. Ask that the Lord reveals Himself as perfect love manifest.

Tuesday:

“I am the bread of life; he who comes to Me will not hunger, and he who believes in Me will never thirst.” John 6:35

Pray for Muslims as they fast, experiencing hunger and thirst. Pray that they would recognise that their works are not enough and that this would prompt them to hunger and thirst for righteousness that can only be found in Christ.

Wednesday:

“Be joyful in hope, patient in affliction, faithful in prayer.” Romans 12:12

Give thanks for Muslim-background believers who have come to faith in the Lord Jesus. Pray that they might have endurance to persevere despite opposition. Pray for the empowering of the church and zeal to witness to families, friends and communities. Pray for protection from the evil one.

Thursday:

“I urge, then, first of all, that petitions, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for all people—for kings and all those in authority, that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness.” 1 Timothy 2:1-2

Pray especially for the salvation of Muslims that hold positions of leadership and for clerics and imams.

Friday:

“But as for me, I watch in hope for the LORD, I wait for God my Saviour; my God will hear me.” Micah 7:7

Pray for Muslim-majority countries that you know of – many are experiencing instability, war and conflict, food shortages and famine. Pray for God’s peace to rest on these nations and for an end to bloodshed. Appeal to God’s mercy on behalf of those suffering. Bring any Muslim-majority countries on your heart before God.

Saturday:

“You are the light of the world. A town built on a hill cannot be hidden.” Matthew 5:14

Pray for Christian workers in Muslim communities where Christ is least known. Pray that they would be faithful in proclaiming the Gospel message and do so in a way which addresses the many felt needs of Muslims. Pray for creativity and wisdom in contextualising the Gospel so it resonates with Muslim people.

Sunday:

“Don’t you have a saying, ‘It’s still four months until harvest’? I tell you, open your eyes and look at the fields! They are ripe for harvest.” John 4:35

Pray for Muslims here in Australia. Pray that Christians would be effective and intentional in reaching out to Muslim friends and neighbours. Pray for the building of bridges and relationships. Pray for churches to be burdened by Muslim people in their community who are living and dying without the Gospel. Give thanks for how God is already at work!
